## Production Numbers

As a matter of interest, I've received the following statistics regarding production of the 914-6. The numbers were obtained from Porsche A.G. via the 914-6 Club of Europe.

As you probably know, model year 1972 sixes were not imported to the U.S.. In addition, there were 15 916 models produced, and two 914-8 models, both of which are at Porsche. The last chassis number of the 914-6 series was 9142430260. This last six was made in June 1972.

In regards to production and U.S. shipments, Volkswagen of America has provided me with a computer printout of all



sixes shipped to the U.S. via their dealer network. They list 1,663 1970 models and 122 1971 models imported by them. If anyone is interested in who the original owner of their car was, I can provide you their name and address in most cases. However, if you do want this information, please provide me with a stamped, self addressed envelope, and I'll be glad to send it to you. Happy hunting from their!

# Parts Information

For better air flow distribution inside all 914-6's, the use of the 1972 and later air distributors under the dash are a significant help. Just order a quantity of two of part number 914.571.349.10 and install in place of your existing ones.

For better air circulation under your six, the installation of the late model air deflectors under the rear firewall are a help. You'll need two of part number 914.559.163.10.

If I can be of any assistance in locating any hard to find items for your six, please let me know. I have, among other 914-6 goodies, an original 914-6 parts catalog, plus versions 1 and 2 with updates. In addition, I have the latest microfiche, shop manuals, and the 914-6 competion catalogs.
